1. offensive language or gestures
2. verbal abuse
3. smoking on school grounds
4. unsportsman like conduct
5. verbal abuse towards umpires, referees, players or coaches

If any of the offenses occur a second time, the person or persons involved will be asked to leave the premises.

Physical assault will result in immediate contact of the local police department and a one-year suspension from all youth commission activities for the child/children of the parent/parents involved.
